In exhaust air operation, the cooking vapours are channelled entirely out of the kitchen through the wall conduct. In both cases, Naber recommends using the currently most effective air duct technology, COMPAIR PRIME flow®. This minimises air resistance so that the extracted cooking vapours flow practically unhindered, even through bends.

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Next level smart home lighting

To create a comfortable atmosphere, the right lighting for the situation is essential. With LUMICA® MEC, Naber has a new generation of LED converters in its range that are highly compatible and greatly simplify the lighting control.
